I am planning a complete report on Jaxon but the stock has been inching higher so I wanted to get an alert out sooner.

What I really like about this one, it has some of the highest grade silver on surface you could find and it is located in B.C. It looks very similar to Eskay Creek, probably one the largest high grade discoveries in B.C., in fact anywhere. Eskay graded about 23 g/t gold with 900 g/t silver.

Jaxon just completed a \$592,000 financing at 7 cents per share to move the company forward for this years exploration season. I did participate in that financing.

Price Creek – Precious & Base Metal VMS Property Location 55 km north of Smithers, BC - 28,000 Ha, Option to earn 100%

The Price Creek property is prospective for world class Eskay Creek and Equity Silver style mineralization with direct shipping ore grades. Widespread soil anomalies and surface showings up to 3,397 g/t Ag, 22.7 g/t Au, and 22.29% Zn have been found on this advanced exploration project, with over 19 known sulphide showings exposed at surface.

The “Knoll” showing at Price Creek was identified by BC department of mines as an Eskay Creek look-alike and contains shallow marine VMS mineralization with an epithermal component of precious and base metals.

Historic Work

- 175 m of trenches in massive sulphide exposures at surface from 11 areas within 1 sq km region.
- Gold values sampled from outcrop up to **22 g/t Au** and lead and zinc values up to 20%.
- 2,500 soil samples over 3 km by 1 km mineralized zone.
- Samples from trenches range up to **1 kg/t Ag to over 3 kg/t Ag** in multiple occurrences over 1 sq km area and 500 m vertical elevation.
- Approximately 2,000 metres of phased drilling in the 1980s

JAX has a 2nd property in B.C., called Wishbone, located 26 km south of Tech Cominco's Schaft Creek. I will have more on that in my report
